(i)(8) Peracetic acid—for use to control fire blight bacteria	Addressed through separate rule-making action; see May 28, 2013 final rule (78 FR 31815).

(c) Calcium chloride, brine process is natural and prohibited for use except as a foliar spray to treat a physiological disorder associated with calcium uptake.	Renew.
<b>§205.605 Nonagricultural (nonorganic) substances allowed as ingredients in or on processed products labeled as “organic” or “made with organic (specified ingredients or food group(s)).”</b>	
(a) Agar-agar.	Renew.
